

# A Journey through Lent with Martha Dawn

Martha Dawn is an internationally respected Theologian and author who serves as Teaching Fellow in Spiritual Theology at Regent College in Vancouver, BC, Canada. She holds four masters degrees and a Ph.D. in Christian Ethics and the Scriptures from the University of Notre Dame. Martha Dawn is also a popular preacher and speaker for people of all ages. She is the author of numerous articles and over 20 books, several of which have won awards and/or been translated into Chinese, Korean, Portuguese, and other languages. Martha and her husband Myron, a retired elementary school teacher, live in southwestern Washington State.



Using short DVD recordings from the workofthepeople.com there will be an opportunity to explore with her a deeper appreciation of God, ourselves and worship.
